The course in civic orientation is given in your native language or another language that you understand. The course will help those who are newly arrived in Sweden to enter the labour market and Swedish society. You will get the chance to listen, ask questions and discuss.

Course content

In Stockholm county the course covers five themes:

- Health
- New in Sweden
- Work and education
- Democracy
- Children and family

Who can attend the course?

Civic orientation is a course for people between 18-64 years old, who have recently arrived in Sweden and either have an establishment plan at Arbetsförmedlingen or are close relative immigrants who have been registered in a municipality for less than three years.



Civic orientation is **not** offered to:

- citizens of an EEA country or Switzerland
- upper secondary level students
- immigrant workers
- visiting students or visiting researchers

Every participant will get a certificate after the course.
