Civic orientation

Are you new in Sweden? Then you might have the right to take a free course in civic orientation. You will learn about your rights and obligations, about Swedish democracy and how the society is organized. The course provides you with important information to ensure a good start in Sweden! The course in civic orientation is given in your native language or another language that you understand. The course will help those who are newly arrived in Sweden to enter the labour market and Swedish society. You will get the chance to listen, ask questions and discuss. Due to the corona pandemic it is now an online course, with one physical meeting the first day of the course.

Course content

In Stockholm county the course covers four themes:

- Welcome to Sweden
- Work and education
- Democracy and participation
- Life in Sweden

Who can attend the course?

Civic orientation is a course for people between 18-64 years old, who have recently arrived in Sweden and either take part in the establishment program at Arbetsförmedlingen or are close relative immigrants who have been registered in Sweden for less than three years.





Civic orientation is **not** offered to:

- citizens of an EEA country or Switzerland
- upper secondary level students
- immigrant workers
- visiting students or visiting researchers
